

# **Jackson County, Georgia Board of Commissioners**

## **“NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE”**

The Jackson County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in total property taxes by 0.88% in unincorporated areas and 2.14% in incorporated areas.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Jackson County Courthouse in the Jury Assembly Room located at 5000 Jackson Parkway, Jefferson, Georgia on October 3, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.

Additional Public hearings on this proposed tax increase will be held at the Jackson County Courthouse in the Jury Assembly Room located at 5000 Jackson Parkway, Jefferson, Georgia on October 10, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 8.860 in the unincorporated areas and 10.120 in the incorporated areas, an increase of 0.25 mills in each area. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.783 mills in unincorporated areas and 9.908 mills in incorporated areas.

The proposed tax increase for a home or nonhomestead property with a fair market value of \$125,000 is approximately \$12.50.
